We perform public community shows on Tuesdays at Lake Wausau and Thursdays at Lake DuBay. We typically have a team practice on Mondays and a specialized practice on Wednesdays, all of which are voluntary participation.

The Safety Coordinator is responsible for maintaining qualified boat personnel at all skiing functions, coordinating boat driving and safety clinics, and has final authority to enforce safety protocol.

The Site and Equipment Coordinator maintains all ski sites, storage unit, and all equipment owned or used by the team as well as coordinating dock and jump installation and removal.

The Ski Reps represent the team as a whole on the Board, resolve grievances and disputes, and promote good team morale and positivity.

# WATER WALKER MEMBERSHIP COMPONENTS

Per team rules and bylaws, **all 5 components** must be completed prior to participation in your first show.

## 1. WATER WALKER MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

All members, skiers and volunteers, must fill out membership paperwork (pages 7-10 of this packet). Families can be on the same form but please include all members that will potentially ski or volunteer. Membership packets will be available at any practice, will be provided via email (to be printed or filled out electronically), or can be completed via our online form: <https://forms.gle/admRaxwM9shUeUXJA>

## 2. WATER WALKER TEAM DUES

Team dues are required by all skiers (not volunteers). These dues help provide funds to keep us on the water.

Individual Skier: \$125

Family (3+ skiers living in same household, children under age 25): \$250

Pay to Play Format: each skier pays \$10 to participate in a show or water practice (up to the total full dues amount (\$125 for individual or \$250 for families)) This option allows flexibility on payments and participation.

Dues will be accepted in person via cash, checks payable to CWWSST, to the team PayPal (can be found with team email: [cwwaterwalkers@gmail.com](mailto:cwwaterwalkers@gmail.com)), or online with a card at [water-walkers.square.site/](http://water-walkers.square.site/).

## 3. WISCONSIN WATER SKI FEDERATION MEMBERSHIP

This membership is part of the state water ski organization. Having WWSF is a great way to support the sport here in Wisconsin and is a necessity for anyone participating at state, including skiing (individually or with the team) or volunteering.

Individual (18 or older): \$15

Family (up to 6 members including children under 18, living in the same household)\*: \$30

Lifetime Individual: \$250

**NEW MEMBERS:** Go to the WWSF website ([www.joinit.org/o/wwsf](http://www.joinit.org/o/wwsf)). Once on the home screen, scroll down to view membership options. Click the green "Join" button for applicable option and fill out info.

**RETURNING MEMBERS:** You should have received an email from WWSF indicating your membership expired on 01/01/2022. Click the green "Renew Membership" button in the email or go to the WWSF website ([www.joinit.org/o/wwsf](http://www.joinit.org/o/wwsf)). Log in to your membership account. Click the green "Renew Membership" button and fill out info.

\*Family Memberships: Please put ALL members of your family on the form since it is very difficult to add later if needed. Family memberships require an email for each member of your family. You may re-use the same email for more than one member of the family. If you require more than 6 in your family membership, use the red "Contact Us" button in the top right corner of the WWSF website to make your request.

## 4. USA WATER SKI MEMBERSHIP

USA Water Ski is a national governing body of which the Water Walkers are an affiliated club. Membership, which includes insurance, is a Water Walker requirement. This includes all skiers, boat drivers, spotters, dock help, announcers, sound technicians, etc. The Water Walker bylaws dictate that anyone under 16 years of age (as of June 1) must have a guardian with USA Water Ski membership as well. The membership is good for 365 days (from the date you register). You may renew your existing membership prior to expiration and it will renew on the date of expiration (i.e., You will not lose days by renewing early). Your membership must be current in order to participate in any practice or show.

**Active Membership:** anyone who goes over the jump, drives a boat, or participates at the state tournament

Under 25 years old: \$55

Adult: \$85

Family (up to 6 members residing at the same address, children under 18)\*: \$175

**Grassroots Membership:** anyone not going over the jump, driving a boat, and not participating at state tournament

All Ages: \$40

**NEW MEMBERS:** Use the "Do not have an account?" section at the bottom. Follow the prompts.

**RETURNING MEMBERS:** USA Water Ski has revamped their website so it will look different to any of the returning members. Use the "Member Login" section at the top. You will need to reset your password on the new site by clicking "I forgot my password". Once logged in, click the red "Renew Membership" button on the homepage and follow the prompts.

It is possible to upgrade from Grassroots to Active or from individual to family later/after signing up but it takes some time and effort. If you have questions about which membership to get, please ask.

## 5. SAFESPORT CERTIFICATION

Beginning in January 2022, all adult members (skiers and volunteers) 18 years old and older will be required to have completed SafeSport Certification per USA Water Ski guidelines. This is a requirement for water practices, shows, tournaments, and land practices. It does not take too long to complete and you do not have to do it all at once. If you have been certified through another sport, submit a copy of that certificate. After you initially complete the course, you will only have to complete a short refresher course each year.

We acknowledge that this is an additional step to complete membership, however we also acknowledge that this is designed to keep USA Water Ski members safe.

### **To complete SafeSport Certification for the FIRST TIME:**

1. Log into your USA Water Ski account: [members.usawaterski.org/member/login](https://members.usawaterski.org/member/login).
2. Click "SafeSport Screening / Background Check" (located about halfway down the screen).
3. Follow the instructions on the page under "First Time Training".
4. You must create an account - save this login information for future years to complete the refresher course. The name of the sport or organization is USA Water Ski.
5. After agreeing to terms and conditions, the SafeSport website will take you to the dashboard. Click on "My Courses" then "SafeSport Trained" (90 minutes).
6. On the next screen, click the blue "Enroll" button then the blue "Start" button.
7. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the course.
8. Once complete, click the "Certificate Instructions" button for complete instructions to download your certificate (the instructions will pop up in a new tab). These instructions include returning to the dashboard (accomplished by clicking the white SafeSport logo in the top left corner), clicking the menu (three horizontal lines) in top right corner, then clicking "Transcripts", and clicking the blue "Download" button next to the completed course. The certificate will open in a new tab.
9. Save the certificate to your computer.
10. Email the certificate to [compliance@usawaterski.org](mailto:compliance@usawaterski.org) AND [LaurenLeurquin@outlook.com](mailto:LaurenLeurquin@outlook.com) (you can CC my email on the same email).

### **To complete SafeSport Certification for RENEWAL:**

1. You should receive an email directly from SafeSport with a link to complete the renewal course and enrollment key. If you would like for me to check when you are due for renewal, let me know and I can do that on our USA roster.
2. You may also log into your USA Water Ski account [members.usawaterski.org/member/login](https://members.usawaterski.org/member/login).
3. Click "SafeSport Screening / Background Check" (located about halfway down the screen).
4. Follow the instructions on the page under "Refresher Training".
5. Log into you SafeSport account:
  1. DO NOT SIGN UP WITH A NEW ACCOUNT
  2. Your username is most likely an email address
  3. Click on "My Courses" then "Refresher 1" (30 minutes). Three refresher courses will show up but you only need to complete one. You will complete one course each year.
6. On the next screen, click the blue "Enroll" button then the blue "Start" button.
7. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the course.
8. Once complete, click the "Certificate Instructions" button for complete instructions to download your certificate (the instructions will pop up in a new tab). These instructions include returning to the dashboard (accomplished by clicking the white SafeSport logo in the top left corner), clicking the menu (three horizontal lines) in top right corner, then clicking "Transcripts", and clicking the blue "Download" button next to the completed course. The certificate will open in a new tab.
9. Save the certificate to your computer.

# *ATHLETIC WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM*

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in The Central Wisconsin Water Ski Show Team's programs and related events and activities, I, as the adult member and/or guardian of a minor member:

1. Agree that prior to participating, they each will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used; and if they believe anything is unsafe, will immediately advise a board member or other adult team member of such conditions and refuse to participate.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
3. Assume all foregoing risks and accept responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
4. Release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Central Wisconsin Water Ski Show Team, it's affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, board members, and other employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releases", from any demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by negligence of the releases or otherwise.
5. Understand that all team memberships will expire on the last day of the calendar year.
6. Understand that all members are required to be affiliated with USA Water Ski and register for insurance purposes with an active or grassroots USA Water Ski membership, paid for by the member.
7. Agree to abide by all rules and regulations of The Central Wisconsin Water Ski Show Team, as set forth in the rules and regulations, code of conduct, and bylaws.

# ADULT AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct gives everyone a guide as to what is expected if we are part of an organization, participating in a sport, or as spectators.

By signing the acknowledgement page, I, as an adult team member or the parent of a minor team member, agree that:

1. I will encourage **good sportsmanship** by demonstrating positive support for all skiers and volunteers at every practice and show.
2. I will promote a **safe and respectful environment** and will encourage my child and other skiers to do so as well.
3. I will **inform those in authority** of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of myself, my child, or the safety of others.
4. I will remember, and will teach my child, that doing one's best is important, however, I will **place the emotional and physical well-being of myself and/or my child ahead of my personal desires** for their achievements.
5. I will **never ridicule** or yell at my child, other participants, or volunteers for making a mistake.
6. I will do my best to make skiing fun and I will remember that I, my child, and other team members participate in **skiing for their own enjoyment and satisfaction**.
7. I and my child will treat all skiers, volunteers, board members, and audience members with **respect**, regardless of race, creed, color, sexual orientation, or ability.
8. I will **applaud a good effort**, emphasizing positive accomplishments and learning from the mistakes.
9. I will, and will encourage my child to, **resolve conflicts** without resorting to hostility or violence.
10. I will be a **positive role model** for my child and other skiers.
11. I will demand a skiing environment for myself and my child that is **free of drugs**, and agree that I will not use or provide to a third party any drug prescribed by the applicable federal, state, or municipal law.
12. I will **not provide alcohol** to, or condone the use of alcohol by, minors or abuse alcohol in the presence of skiers.
13. I will respect those in authority and will **refrain from coaching my child or other skiers** during practices because it may conflict with the show director's plan or strategies.
14. I will recognize the **importance of volunteering and show appreciation for other volunteers** and club officials.
15. I will **respect the volunteer Board of Directors** and refrain from criticizing their actions. However, I understand that I can address the Board of Directors directly via e-mail, phone, or at a board meeting.
16. I will not compare myself or my child's skill level or number of show acts to other skiers on the team.

\*Concerns regarding the Adult and Parent Code of Conduct may be addressed in writing to the Board of Directors.

# *RULES AND EXPECTATIONS OF ALL MEMBERS*

\*The following rules may or may not be part of the official team bylaws but have been approved by the Board of Directors.

1. All team members will participate in team practices, shows, and tournaments to the best of their abilities as a skier or a volunteer.
2. During the ski season, all members are required to volunteer and contribute off the water. During the off-season, members are expected to participate in the team fundraiser(s).
3. Team members are responsible for payment of their own USA Water Ski and Wisconsin Federation dues.
4. Any member under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or designated adult at all club functions, including practices and shows, at all times.
5. All applications are subject to approval and possible background check by the Board of Directors of the Water Walkers prior to becoming a member and participating in any club function.
6. All members are expected to display good sportsmanship and respect for all people at all times.
7. All members are to be a positive role model for fellow team members and the community.
8. Members are expected to display caution and care for all equipment owned by the team, self, or others.
9. All members are expected to volunteer and participate in fundraising, promotional activities, and other team activities.
10. Members shall follow all Federal, State, and local laws, rules, ordinances, and policies, and assume consequences by the authorities and/or team for non-compliance.
11. No team member shall be present or participate in team activities under the influence of any mind altering substance including alcohol. Under the influence is defined as detectable level of substance, or if participation would be a risk or danger to themselves or others.
12. No member shall use or encourage use of any amount of alcohol, drug, or controlled substance to any member under legal age, regardless of whether it is a team activity or not.
13. Smoking will not be permitted by anyone under legal age, or by anyone in boats or skier areas.
14. Unauthorized or improper use of equipment (team or individual) will not be tolerated. Team equipment may not be used by an individual outside of an approved scheduled team practice or show unless properly approved and signed out.
15. Non-members shall never be allowed in boats nor in equipment storage or staging areas during ski functions.
16. Those without active USA insurance shall not actively participate in shows, practices, be in team boats, or on team dock.
17. Team boats may be used only during approved scheduled practice, show, or team activity.
18. Proper floatation shall be used for all designated water ski acts, as per Safety Coordinator instruction and/or current law or USA Water Ski guidelines.
19. Reckless conduct and behavior shall result in removal of member privileges.
20. Any unsportsmanlike conduct by team members and/or behavior causing a negative impact on the team may be penalized at the discretion of the Board.
21. Notify the show director ASAP via Sign Up Genius or in writing if you will be absent from a show. Special circumstances will be taken into consideration.
22. The Show Director has final authority of show line up. Other members are not to change the show board without authorization from the Show Director.
23. The Safety Coordinator has final authority regarding safety during shows and practices.
24. Show acts will be towed by the boat that fits the flow of the show, not by skier's boat preference.
25. Members shall demonstrate and promote safe practices and responsible behavior on and off the water.
26. Any grievance by a member shall be resolved in the manner laid out by the team bylaws.
27. Members will abide by the bylaws of the Central Wisconsin Water Ski Show Team which have been made available to me via email and on the team website.

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If rules are violated:

A written, documented, and signed allegation shall be presented before the Board of Directors. The Board shall vote to determine the consequences. The Board, by majority vote, may determine the next course of action. The Board is given full and final authority to select the best course of action. Membership suspension and termination will be executed as per the team bylaws.
